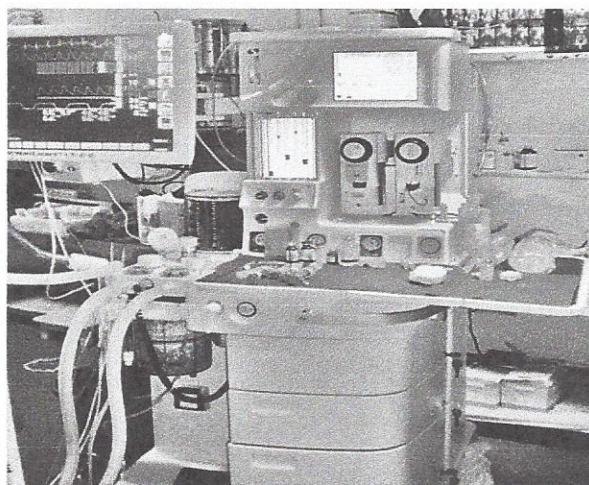

--State of the Art Anaesthesia work stations with multipara monitor .



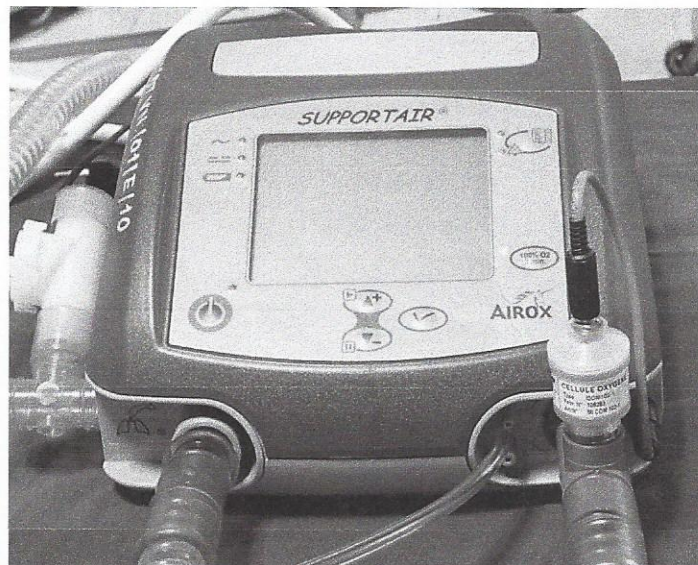

- 2) Critical care for post operative surgical cases

- 4) Anaesthesia at remote locations like CT-MRI, Endoscopy unit
- 5) Emergency and trauma services
- 6) Post operative analgesia
- 7) Monitored anaesthesia care
