OT block has a seperate Ophthalmic fully equipped O T with well trained staff for Ophthalmic Surgeries

- A-Scan for Intra Ocular Lens power calculation.
- Prism Bars for Squint evaluation.

LASER Room:-

- Slit-lamp mounted Argon Green Retinal laser with Pan Retinal Lens & Macular grid laserlenses.
- LASER Indirect Ophthalmoscope with 20 D lens.

- Phacoemulsification machine with inbuilt diathermy and a complete retinal surgery module.
- Operating Microscope.
