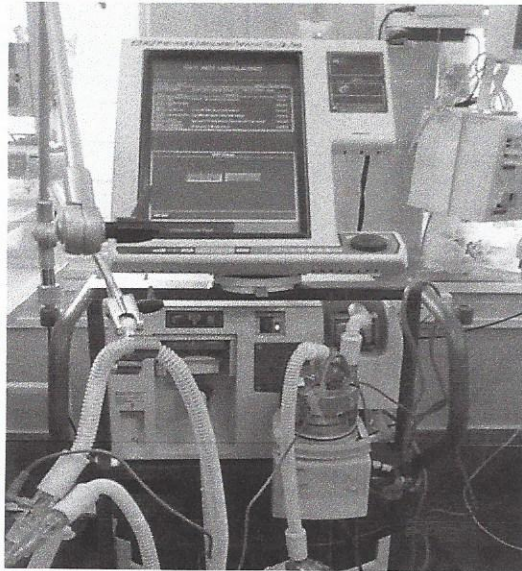

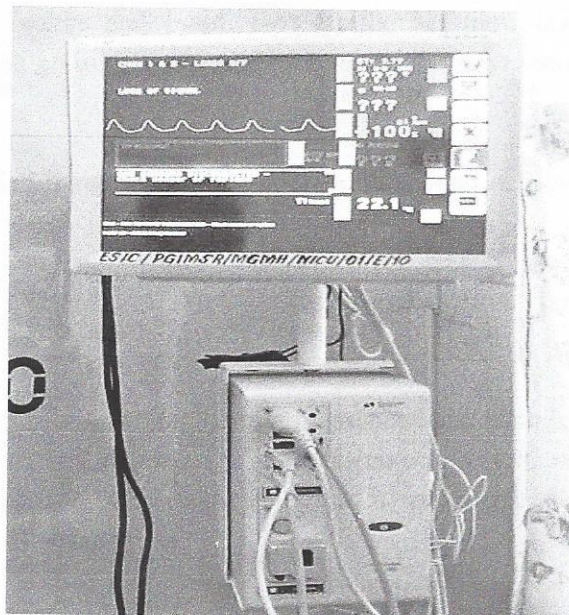
Equipments:

Academic training:
