Allotment of PG Degree seats at ESI-PGIMSR, Andheri, Mumbai

As per the judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, following is the pattern of seat allotment:

- Of the total number of PG seats (without any exclusion), 50% is contributed towards All India Quota and these seats shall be filled up on all India basis through AIPGMEE.
- Rest 50% of the total number of seats shall be filled up by State Quota candidates PGM-CET.

ESIC Bond: On Non judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/-

As per ESIC Bond student shall serve any of the Institution of ESIC or of the ESI Scheme of the State Govt. as the case may be for **05 (five) years**. In case of default pay to Corporation total bond amount of **Rs.25,00,000/-** (Rs. **Twenty Five lakhs**) along with interest @ 15% p.a.

Revised Bond format is given below:

Annual Tuition Fee from Academic Year 2017-18 would be charged Rs.2.5 lakh as per ESIC Hqrs. memorandum No. L-11/12/3/2010/ Corporate Cell-Vol.II /MED dated 13/01/2017.

Duration of compulsory service under Bond should be '05' (five) years, the student shall serve any of the Institution of ESIC anywhere in India or of the ESI Scheme of the State Govt. as the case may be for five years.

- The tuition fee would be payable in two equal half yearly instalments for both, UG and PG courses. However, 'Wards of IPs' would continue to pay annual tuition fee of ₹ 24,000/- as a single instalment (yearly).
- The Deans are to communicate the Fee structure and Bond conditions with copy of Bond document to the concerned Appropriate Authority for admissions to these courses under All India Quota and State Quota for the year 2017-18 and onwards. The concerned Affiliating University is also to be informed as per requirement. The revised Bond document for UG and PG courses is enclosed.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Office Memorandum of even no dated 13th January, 2017 on the captioned subject and to inform as under:

- 1) The enhanced tuition fee would apply to;
 - A. All students, other than "Wards of Insured Persons", who seek admission to MBBS / BDS courses in ESIC Medical / Dental Colleges from academic session 2017-18 and onwards.
 - B. All students who seek admission to MD / MS courses in ESIC Medical Education Institutions from academic session 2017-18 and onwards.
- 2) The enhancement would not be applicable retrospectively, i.e. all students admitted to MBBS / BDS / MD / MS courses in ESIC Medical Education Institutions prior to academic session 2017-18 would continue to pay the pre-revised tuition fee i.e. Rupees 24,000/- per annum for the duration of their respective course.
- 3) This is issued with the approval of Director General.

NOW the condition of the above written obligation is that in the event the Bounden discontinues the study or after completion of the MD/MS Course of study to which he/she was selected, fails to serve the Corporation for period of five years, the Bounden and sureties shall forthwith pay to the Corporation on demand the total amount of Rs 25, 00,000 (Rupees Twenty five lakh only) with interest @ 15% towards failure fulfill the obligation. The bond is legally binding on the bounden and the sureties and upon the payment of such sum the above written obligation shall be void and of no effect otherwise this shall remain in full force and effect:

PROVIDED further that the bounden and the sureties do hereby agree that if the Bounden discontinues the study or after completion of the PG (MD/MS) Course of study to which he/she was selected, fails to serve the Corporation for a period of five years, it may be construed as professional misconduct and the fact reported to the Medical Council of India or of the Medical Council of the State concerned for suitable action including cancellation of Registration by the Council:

PROVIDED further that the bounden and the sureties do hereby agree that all sums found due to the Corporation under or by virtue of this bond shall be recovered jointly and severally from them and their properties movable and immovable as if such dues were arrears of land revenue under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act for the time being in force or in such other manner as the Corporation may deem fit.

Provided further that it is not necessary for the Corporation to sue the bond holder before taking action on the surety, under this bond and the liabilities of the sureties is Co-extensive with that of the Bounden and shall not be affected by the Corporation giving time or any other indulgence to the bounden or by the Corporation varying of the terms and conditions herein contained,
